CBD Beginnings: Will I Fail a Drug Test?

Clients may ask how CBD will affect a drug test. For those individuals subject to random drug tests, mandated for federal employees and many private sector employees, the idea of using CBD can be a concern.

Drug tests usually follow *SAMHA* guidelines to keep the testers on legal grounds. Normal drug screens are set up to only screen for one specific property in cannabis, *THC*. Regardless of the amount of CBD in their system when tested, they should not fail.

Although hemp sourced CBD products are mainly advertised as *THC* free, there can be small amounts buried inside; but most are usually non-detectable when tested. This is why we use third party tested isolate. If a client uses upwards of 1000mg of CBD a day, they might trigger a false positive and trigger the confirmatory *GC/MS* test which would just come back a negative. For a point of reference, most CBD users consume as little as 20mg to 400mg per day. Also lots of common legal products can cause a false positive.

CBD is like other products

Here is an example ... beer. Most domestic beers contain between 4.2 and 5.5 percent ABV (alcohol by volume), yet non-alcoholic versions of beer have only around 0.4 percent ABV. There is still alcohol in non-alcoholic beer, but not enough to get you intoxicated.

This is the same in most reputable CBD products like CUBED Naturals that can legally contain no more than 0.3 percent *THC*.

When Used Properly: No High / No Failed Test
